



## Max Foundation

Max Foundation is an ambitious non-profit organization created by the initiative of Steven and Joke Le Poole in 2002. Max works with local communities on providing children a healthy start in life by providing safe water, sanitation & hygiene, nutrition, and care. Our approach is focused on result: child health and the prevention of stunting, and is based on evidence of what works. Our unique Healthy Village approach is a cornerstone of our work, in which we combine the thematic areas of WASH, nutrition and health, has now reached 3 million people, 75,000 children monitored, with 12 million invested.

Max Foundation has programs in Bangladesh, Ethiopia, and Nepal and is expanding into other developing countries, working in close partnerships with other NGOs to enable rapid growth. Our character is entrepreneurial, enthusiastic, and informal, while striving for efficiency. Max Foundation's focus on the maximum value for money spent distinguishes us from many other charities. We work evidence based, using innovative new approaches such as the Max Social Enterprise piped water networks in Bangladesh.

## Supervisory Board

The Max Foundation is led on a day-to-day basis by a two persons Executive Board: Joke Le Poole and Marjolijn Wilmlink and is overseen by the Supervisory Board, which currently consists of five members.

The Supervisory Board is primarily responsible for the juridical, organizational, and financial integrity of the foundation and formally approves the foundation's financial and strategic policies, budget, and plans, as proposed by the Executive Board. In addition to its supervisory role, the Supervisory Board acts as a sounding board for the operational team, where each board member brings in relevant expertise and experience.

Max Foundation's Supervisory Board members are not remunerated for their work, except for the reimbursement of expenses – as legally required for the foundation's ANBI-status.
